Massachusetts Poll Watcher Legislation

The state committee of a political party may appoint a person to act as a challenger of voters at any polling place in the commonwealth at a state election (Mass. Gen. Laws ch. 54, § 85A).

Observers are allowed inside the polling place, outside the guardrail (Massachusetts Secretary of State Election Day Legal Summary). Any election officer or other person may challenge a person's right to vote for any legal cause (Massachusetts Secretary of State Election Day Legal Summary).
